HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 313, L. D. 406, Bill, "An Act  
Increasing Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out the 6th, 7th  
and 8th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'personal property, sold at retail in this State on and after  
July 1, 1963 ~~and-upon-the-rental-charged-for-living-quarters  
in-hotels,-rooming-houses,-tourist-or-trailer-camps,-measured  
by-the-sale-price,~~ except as in this '

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 3 a new  
section to read as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. Repeal. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
with this act are hereby repealed or amended to conform thereto.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 a new  
section to read as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. Further effective date. The provisions of this  
act as they relate to the repeal of the tax on rentals shall  
become effective January 1, 1964.'
