COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 149, L. D. 426, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Penalties for Possession of Narcotic Drugs."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end a new section to read
as follows:

"Sec. 7. R. S., c. 141, §1, amended. The first sentence of
section 1 of chapter 141 of the Revised Statutes is amended to
read as follows:

*All places used as houses of ill fame, or for the illegal sale or
keeping of intoxicating liquors or narcotic drugs, or resorted to
for lewdness or gambling; all houses, shops or places where
intoxicating liquors are sold for tippling purposes, and all places
of resort where intoxicating liquors are kept, sold, given away,
drunk or dispensed in any manner not provided for by law are
common nuisances.'"
