**AN ACT Relating to Restoration to Service of Disability Retirants Under State Retirement System.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 63-A, § 8, amended.** Section 8 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, and as amended by chapter 130 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

**'In the event a disability retirant returns to active service after age 55, he may be allowed the regular benefit on subsequent retirement if he repays into the system the total amount of benefits which he received prior to his return to active service.'**
