HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S. P. 129, L. D. 442, Joint Resolution
Memorializing Congress Recommending Full Development
of Electric Power Potential of Passamaquoddy Bay and
Upper Saint John River.

Amend said Joint Resolution by striking out all of the
6th paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Resolved: That the 101st Legislature recommends the
full development of the electric power potential of Passamaquoddy
Bay and such supplemental development of the electric power
potential of the Upper Saint John River as may be recommended
as economically feasible by studies now underway by the
Department of the Interior without substantial destruction of
the recreational and industrial advantages now recognized as
existing in the St. John River area, and that necessary inter-
connecting transmission facilities be provided between the
projects and the load centers of the Northeast to provide the
optimum benefits to the United States and Canada; and be it
further'
