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## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 101st LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 183, L. D. 482, Bill, "An Act Revising the Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting after the words "An Act" the words 'Increasing Minimum Wages and'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 3, the following:

"Sec. 3-A. R. S., c. 30, \$132-C, amended. Section 132-C of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the public laws of 1959 and amended by section 6 of chapter 277 of the public laws of 1961, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 132-C. Prohibition of employment except as provided for.

By reason of the declaration of policy set forth in section 132-A and in the protection of the industry or business and in the enhancement of public interest, health, safety and welfare, it is declared unlawful for any employer to employ any employee except as otherwise provided in Sections 132-A to 132-J at the rate of less than \$1 \$1.15 per hour.'"
