SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 183, L. D. 482, Bill, "An Act
Revising the Minimum Wage Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the part
designated paragraph "D." of section 2 and inserting in
place thereof the following:

"D. Any individual engaged in the activities of a
public-supported nonprofit organization or in a
program controlled by an educational nonprofit
organization or employed in domestic service in
a private nursing home, or employed in domestic service in
a private hospital;"
