IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Revising the Beano or Bingo Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 139, § 23-A, additional. Chapter 139 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section, to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 23-A. Additional conditions of license. In addition to the rules and regulations promulgated under section 24, the license shall be issued under the following conditions:
 - I. Limit. All prizes, tokens or awards used, given, offered or awarded during, after or in connection with the conduct of any game or series of games conducted in any week may be paid in cash and shall not exceed the total amount of \$400.
 - II. Door prizes. Door prizes shall be legal.
 - III. Type of play. If announced at the start of every game, the 4 corners and diamond on the card may be played.'
