HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1117, L. D. 1600, Resolve,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Affecting
the Election, Powers and Apportionment of the House
of Representatives.

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end of the
3rd paragraph the following new sentence:
'Each county shall be entitled to that number of Representatives
which is in the same proportion to the total number of
Representatives as the number of inhabitants of the county
bears to the number of inhabitants of the State, fractional
excesses over whole numbers to be computed in favor of the
counties having the larger fractional excesses.'
