HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1117, L.D. 1600, Resolve,

Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Affecting
the Election, Powers and Apportionment of the House
of Representatives.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence of the next to the last paragraph of that
part designated "Section 3." and inserting in place thereof
the following underlined sentence: 'Cities and towns entitled
to two or more Representatives under the foregoing procedure may,
by affirmative vote of both Houses of the Legislature, be
organized into single member districts whereby each legally
qualified elector therein is entitled to vote for only one
Representative, provided that all such cities and towns
are so organized.'
