COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1134, L. D. 1605, Resolve,  
Appropriating Funds for Community Mental Health Services.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the paragraph  
before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Community Mental Health Services program; appropriation.  
Resolved: That there is appropriated from any moneys in the  
General Fund not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$40,000;  
for the purpose of re-establishing a discontinued Community  
Mental Health Services program; for the purpose of assisting  
currently operating Community Mental Health Services in the  
retention of existing, and in the adoption of new, programs;  
and for the purpose of assisting Maine communities in the  
establishment of much needed, and yet nonexistent, Community  
Mental Health Services programs.

The breakdown of such appropriation to be as follows:

1963-64

MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS,  
DEPARTMENT OF

Community Mental Health Services

All Other \$40,000

(Of the above amount, \$20,000 shall  
be carried forward at June 30, 1964  
into the 1964-65 fiscal year to be  
used for the same purposes.)'
