COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.9, L.D. 9, "Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Eliminate Voting Restrictions on Paupers and Persons under Guardianship."

Amend said Resolve, in the Title, by striking out the words "and Persons under Guardianship"

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 8th line and inserting in place thereof the following: 'years and upwards, excepting paupers-and persons under guardianship for reasons of mental infirmities.'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out, in the 30th and 31st lines, the words "and Persons under Guardianship"
