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**AN ACT Relating to Dedication of Student Payments and Fees at the State Teachers Colleges and State Vocational-Technical Institutes.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Student payments and fees dedicated.** All tuition and other students payments and fees, including payments for board and room, except such payments as are reserved for the amortization of the principal and of the interest on self-amortizing dormitory and dining facilities bonds, at the state teachers colleges and state vocational-technical institutes shall be credited to the appropriate accounts at the respective teachers colleges and vocational-technical institutes and shall be available for expenditure upon allotment by the Governor and Council as provided in the Revised Statutes of 164, Title 5, section 1667.
