## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Loans by Banks to Development Credit Corporation of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 104, § 6, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 6 of chapter 104 of the private and special laws of 1949 is amended to read as follows:

'Each member shall lend funds to this corporation as and when called upon by it to do so, but the total amount on loan by any member at any one time shall not exceed the following limit, to be determined as of the time of its becoming a member: for commercial banks and trust companies,  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  of capital and, surplus and undivided profits; for savings banks,  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  of reserve funds; for loan and building associations,  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  of guaranty funds; for insurance companies,  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  of capital and surplus; and comparable limits for other banking institutions.'
