COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 198, L. D. 579, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Possession of Firearms by Felons."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence
of that part designated "§393." of section 2 and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'It shall be unlawful for any person who has been convicted of a
felony under the laws of the United States or of the State of Maine,
or of any other state, to have in his possession any pistol, re-
volver or any other firearm capable of being concealed upon the
person until the expiration of 5 years from the date of his
discharge or release from prison or termination of probation.'
