STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Liability for Damages for Tortious Conduct of Charitable Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 156, additional. Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 156 to read as follows:

'Sec. 156. Damages for tortious conduct of charitable corporations. A corporation, organized for charitable or benevolent purposes, shall be liable for damages arising out of its tortious conduct to the same extent as if it were a private person.'
