IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Regulating Use of Pesticides on and Adjacent to Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Regulating the use of pesticides on and adjacent to Sebago Lake. It shall be unlawful to spray or apply any insecticide within 150 yards of Sebago Lake and its tributaries in the County of Cumberland. This shall not apply to application within dwellings or within other buildings.
