**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Maine Educational Television Network
for Outside Audience Training.**

Maine Educational Television network; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to the Director of the Maine Educational Television Network to provide funds to employ secretarial help and to provide for necessary traveling expenses of the director in accordance with the following schedule:
