COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 452, L.D. 606, Resolve,
Authorizing the Establishment of a Residential and
Day School for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 2nd,
3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th
lines and inserting in place thereof the following:
'the sum of \$105,057 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966
and the sum of \$74,425 for the fiscal year ending June 30,
1967 for the purpose of establishing and operating a residential
and day school, under the supervision of the Department of
Mental Health and Corrections for the provision of education
and training for the mentally retarded according to the
following schedule:
