RESOLVE, in Favor of Roland S. Rose of Arundel for Well Damage by Highway Construction.

Roland S. Rose; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,731 to be paid to Roland S. Rose, of Arundel, as a settlement of his claim against the State for damages, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to a well on his property caused by the use of salt on Route 1 in Arundel.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Roland S. Rose claims contamination of his water system by salt used by the State Highway Commission. In June, 1964, his water tested 280 P.P.M. of chloride (250 P.P.M. is sea water) which made it impossible to use in his restaurant and coffee house. This necessitated the drilling of a new artesian well and the installation of equipment at a cost of \$1,731.
