AN ACT Relating to Conveyance of Secondary School Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 3561, amended. The 4th sentence of section 3561 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

‘The superintendent of schools in each town shall procure the conveyance of all elementary **and secondary** school pupils residing in his town, a part or the whole of the distance, to and from the nearest suitable school, for the number of weeks for which schools are maintained in each year, when such pupils reside at such a distance from the said school as in the judgment of the superintending school committee shall render such conveyance necessary.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective for the school year 1966-67.
