AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Firemen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 7, additional. Section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 7, to read as follows:

‘7. Minimum wage for firemen. Members of municipal fire fighting departments, other than volunteer or call-departments, who are paid salaries or regular wages, are deemed to be employees within the meaning of this section, are covered by chapter 7, subchapter III.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective May 1, 1966.
