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**AN ACT Relating to Advertising for Applicants for Employment.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 17, § 1620-A, additional.** Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1620-A to read as follows:

‘Sec. 1620-A. Advertising for applicants for employment. No person, firm or corporation shall advertise for applicants for employment in any newspaper or magazine published in this State unless the name of such person, firm or corporation is publicly indicated in said advertisement. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.’
