STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Elevator Under Elevator Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 401, sub-§ 5, amended. The first sentence of subsection 5 of section 401 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

"Elevator" shall mean a hoisting and lowering mechanism equipped with a car or platform or load-carrying unit which moves in guides is guided in a substantially vertical direction, and shall include the doors, well, enclosures, means and appurtenances required by these regulations."
