AN ACT Relating to Lighting of Premises Licensed for Sale of Liquor to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 854, amended. Section 854 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 854. Lighting of premises

All premises licensed for sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises shall be adequately lighted, as determined by the use of a light meter. The commission shall establish uniform, minimum standards of, and the kind of, light meter to be use. The license of any person violating this section shall be suspended until the licensee has conformed to the requirements of this section.'
