STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sales Tax on Rooming House Rentals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 1752, sub-§ 12, amended. Subsection 12 of section 1752 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '12. Rooming house. "Rooming house" means every house, boat, vehicle, motor court, trailer court or other structure or any place or location kept, used, maintained, advertised or held out to the public to be a place where living quarters are supplied for pay to transient or permanent guests or tenants, whether in one or adjoining buildings and including single seasonal rooms or camps rented by or on behalf of any person.'
