IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Establishing Clerk of Courts in Androscoggin County as Full-Time and Providing Compensation Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 554, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 554 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'The office of clerk of courts in Androscoggin County is designated a full-time county office.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts of Androscoggin County, is amended to read as follows:

'clerk of courts, \$5,800 \$11,600;'
