COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 954, L.D. 1290, Resolve, Designating May Mountain in Island Falls as Robinson Mountain.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title the following:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts and resolves do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted or passed as emergencies; and

Whereas, the date of President Lincoln's death was April 14, 1865; and

Whereas, to honor and perpetuate the memory of George F. Robinson is vital to Maine's tradition to honor its heros of all Wars; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof the following:

'<u>Emergency clause</u>. In the view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
