COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 954, L.D. 1290, Resolve,  
Designating May Mountain in Island Falls as Robinson  
Mountain.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title the  
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves do  
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless  
enacted or passed as emergencies; and

Whereas, the date of President Lincoln's death was  
April 14, 1865; and

Whereas, to honor and perpetuate the memory of George  
F. Robinson is vital to Maine's tradition to honor its heroes  
of all Wars; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Con-  
stitution of Maine and require the following legislation  
as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end  
thereof the following:

'Emergency clause. In the view of the emergency  
cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when  
approved.'
