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**RESOLVE, Designating May Mountain in Island Falls as Robinson Mountain.**

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**May Mountain in Island Falls designated as Robinson Mountain. Resolved:** That in recognition of the extraordinary heroism of Sergeant George F. Robinson, Company K, Eighth Regiment of Maine Volunteers, in saving William H. Seward, Secretary of State of the United States, from assassination on April 14, 1865, that May Mountain in the Town of Island Falls, from which Sergeant Robinson entered the military service, shall be officially designated as, and henceforth referred to, as Robinson Mountain.
