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## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 964, L. D. 1299, Bill, "An Act Relating to Licensing of Embalmers, Funeral Directors and Funeral Homes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, §1502, amended. The 4th and 5th paragraphs of section 1502 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'All funeral establishments must be operated by a person or persons holding a funeral director's license, must employ full-time a person or persons holding an embalmer's license or a combination embalmer and funeral director's license and must be registered by the board. Said license and certificate of registration shall be conspicuously displayed at or in such establishments.

All branch establishments must be operated by a person or persons holding a funeral director's license, must employ full-time a person or persons holding an embalmer's license or a combination embalmer and funeral director's license and must be registered by the poard. Said license and certificate of registration shall be conspicuously displayed at or in such establishments.'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the 3rd underlined sentence of that part designated "§1504." of section 3 the following underlined sentences:

'Any person holding an embalmer's license or a funeral director's license issued under this or any other law, may, when not actively engaged in the profession of embalming and funeral directing, request the Board of Examiners of Funeral Directors and Embalmers to hold said licenses in a nonactive or dormant status without cost to the petitioner Petitioner may, upon future request, have said licenses reactivated by paying the required fee for the current year.'
