HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 989, L.D. 1334, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Unlawful Practices Under Unfair Sales
Act."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the
single quotation mark the following new sentences:

'Failure of opportunity by the consumer to purchase such
merchandise shall be prima facie evidence of violation of
this section. In addition to the penalties provided in
this chapter any person refused the right to purchase a
reasonable quantity of merchandise advertised or offered
for sale below its cost basis may maintain an action in
any court of equitable jurisdiction to prevent, restrain
or enjoin further violation of this chapter.'
