COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 37, L.D. 57, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Citizenship Requirement for Municipal
Assessors."

Amend said bill by striking out all of 18th, 19th
and 20th lines of the bill (17th, 18th and 19th in L.D.)
and inserting in place thereof 'In order to hold a municipal
office, a person must be a resident of the State and at least
21 years of age and, except in the case of assessors, a
citizen of the United States.'
