STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Life Preservers for Canoes Operated on Inland Waters of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 38, § 238, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, additional. Subsection 1 of section 238 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph B, to read as follows:
 - B. All canoes or similar watercraft shall carry at least one U. S. Coast Guard approved life saving device labelled as such for each person aboard. Said devices shall be maintained in good and serviceable condition and be readily accessible at all times. The owner or operator or both shall be responsible to see that the watercraft specified in this paragraph is equipped before operating or giving permission to operate said watercraft.
