RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Franklin County.

Fishing in certain waters in Franklin County; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Long Pond, Sandy River Plantation, permitting fly fishing and trolling only, except that bait fishing is permitted from a permanent wharf or shore after May 20th. The daily limit shall be 4 fish and the tributaries shall be open.
