COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 301, L.D. 740, Bill, "An Act Revising the Laws Relating to Arson."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

' R. S., T. 17, §151, amended. The first 2 sentences of section 151 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

Whoever willfully and maliciously sets fire to or causes fire to be set to the dwelling house or house trailer or mobile home or any building occupied in part for dwelling or lodginghouse purposes and belonging wholly or in part to himself, his wife or to another, or to any building adjoining thereto owned wholly or in part by himself, his wife or another, with intent to burn such dwelling house or building, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than 20 years. Whoever willfully and maliciously sets fire to or causes fire to be set to a dwelling house or house trailer or mobile home or any building owned by himself, and thereby endangers a dwelling house or other property of his wife or of another, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than 20 years.'
