AN ACT Relating to Sale of Malt Liquor in Retail Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 751-A, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 751-A, as follows:

§ 751-A. Payment for sales in retail stores

For the purpose of receiving payment at the check-out counters for the sale of malt liquor in retail stores, the age of such employee receiving the payment shall not be under 16 years of age, provided that an employee who is 21 years of age or older is present in the retail store in a supervisory capacity.
