STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Benefits to Widows of State Police Members
Retired Under Noncontributory Statute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 25, § 1595, amended. Section 1595 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 387 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end thereof, the following paragraph:

A surviving widow shall receive any increase in allowances to which her husband would have been entitled were he living.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to September 3, 1965.
