RESOLVE, to Permit David Carnevale to Obtain Disability Retirement Allowance.

David Carnevale to qualify for disability retirement allowance. Resolved:

That the Maine State Retirement System is directed to permit David Carnevale to apply for a disability retirement allowance and in the computation thereof shall allow credit for one year of teaching service to make a minimum of 10 years of creditable service to establish a minimum disability retirement allowance.
