STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Approval of Plans and Competitive Bids Under Bureau of Public Improvements Law.

Be in enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1742, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 1742 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 7. Approve plans for public improvements. To approve all proposals, plans, specifications and contracts for public improvements which require their submission to the Governor and Council for their final approval and acceptance;
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 1743, amended. The first paragraph of section 1743 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any contract for any public improvement involving a total cost of more than \$3,000 \$10,000, except contracts for professional, architectural and engineering services, shall be awarded by a system of competitive bidding in accordance with chapters 141 to 155 and such other conditions and restrictions as the Governor and Council may from time to time prescribe.
