SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 559, L. D. 791, Bill, "An Act
Decreasing Annual Expenditure for Economic and Recreational
Development in Oxford County."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words
"Decreasing Annual Expenditure for" and inserting in place thereof
the words 'Relating to'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. R.S., T. 10, §911, amended. Section 911 of Title 10
of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 122 of the public
laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end the following new
paragraph:

Any county commissioner of Oxford County who exceeds the
appropriation authorized by this section shall be guilty of a
misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine
of not more than \$300 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days,
or by both.'
