STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Decreasing Annual Expenditure for Economic and Recreational Development in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 911, amended. The first sentence of section 911 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 122 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

In order to attract new and additional industries to Oxford County and to encourage expansion of industries presently located in Oxford County and to develop and attract new recreational industries, the county commissioners are authorized to expend not exceeding the sum of \$35,000 \$20,000 annually under the direction of the county commissioners, to be accounted for as other moneys of the county, for economic and recreational development within said county of Oxford.
