COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 577, L.D. 809, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Opening and Closing Time for Polls."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line (4th line
of L.D. 809) the underlined figure "8" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined figure '7'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 11th line
(8th line of L.D. 809) the underlined figure "9" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined figure '7'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Exceptions. In any municipality, the municipal
officers may permit the polls to remain open till-9-8 p.m. on
election day in a voting place which uses voting machines
exclusively.'
