**AN ACT to Prohibit Unauthorized Throwing or Distributing of Handbills in
or upon Vehicles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 2253, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2253, to read as follows:

§ 2253. Throwing or distributing of handbills

No person shall throw or deposit any handbill in or upon any vehicle. A handbill is any sample, device, dodger, circular, leaflet, pamphlet, paper, booklet or any other printed or otherwise reproduced original or copies of any matter of literature. Nothing contained in this section shall be construed as affecting the right of a person to hand out or distribute handbills to any person in a vehicle who is willing to accept such matter. Any person who violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.
