## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Permitting Salvation Army to Solicit Funds Within State Liquor Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 157, additional.** Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 157, to read as follows:

§ 157. Salvation Army to solicit funds

During business hours at state stores, the Salvation Army shall be permitted to remain in the stores to solicit funds for its activities.
