**AN ACT Relating to Excise Tax on Motor Vehicles.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 36, § 1482, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, amended.** Paragraph C of subsection 1 of section 1482 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**C. Motor vehicles.** For the privilege of operating a motor vehicle upon the public ways, each motor vehicle, other than a stock race car, to be so operated shall be subject to such excise tax as follows: A sum equal to 23 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the first or current year of model, 16½ mills for the 2nd year, 12½ mills for the 3rd year, 9 mills for the 4th year, 5½ mills for the 5th year and 3 mills for the 6th and succeeding years. The minimum tax for a motor vehicle other than bicycle with motor attached shall be ~~5~~ \$15, for bicycle with motor attached, \$2.50. The excise tax on a stock race car shall be \$5. The maximum tax on and after the ~~7th~~ 4th year of model for a passenger vehicle, including a so-called station wagon, but not a bus, shall be ~~15~~ \$50.
