RESOLVE, Reimbursing Mark Harrington of Phippsburg for Well Damage by Road Construction.

Mark Harrington; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Mark Harrington of Phippsburg as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his domestic water supply caused by road construction and the depositing of salt on his premises.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The road was raised and widened and all salt, etc. drained onto Mr. Harrington's land located on the road from Bath to Phippsburg Center.
