AN ACT Relating to Protective Headgear by Persons Riding Motorcycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1371, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1371, to read as follows:

§ 1371. Protective headgear for motorcycle riders

Every person operating a motorcycle or motor driven cycle, or riding as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor driven cycle or in a sidecar attached to a motorcycle or motor driven cycle shall wear protective headgear conforming with each minimum standards of construction and performance as the Secretary of State may prescribe.
