SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1102, L. D. 1569, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Quality of Inspection Stickers for Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the words  
"Quality of".

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting  
clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, §2122, amended. The first sentence  
of the 4th paragraph of section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised  
Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Said inspection shall not apply to motor vehicles owned and  
registered in another state nor to new or used motor vehicles  
being driven by a dealer or holder of a transporter registration  
certificate or their authorized representatives from the point  
of distribution to his place of business, or a motor vehicle  
owned by a dealer or holder of a transporter registration that  
has a valid sticker until such time as the inspection sticker  
would have otherwise expired, at which time the motor vehicle  
must be reinspected.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 and 2 to be  
sections 2 and 3.
