AN ACT Relating to Quality of Inspection Stickers for Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The last paragraph of section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the 2nd sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

The stickers shall be made of such material and quality of adhesive as prescribed by the Chief of the State Police.

Sec. 2. Allocation. There shall be allocated from the General Highway Fund to Appropriation No. 9026 the sum of \$8,500 for the fiscal year 1967-1968 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
