SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 594, L. D. 1572, Bill, "An Act to Revise Utility Location Permits in Public Highways."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2483." of section 6 by adding to subsection 1 the following new paragraphs C and D:

'C. "Federal-aid highway system" shall consist of highways selected or designated by the State Highway Commission and approved by the Secretary, Department of Transportation, in accordance with 23 U. S. Code Section 103.

D. "Compact areas" shall in section 2346 and this section mean an area within a municipality having a population over 5,000 where structures on land adjacent to the highway are nearer than 200 feet apart for a distance of 1/4 of a mile.'
